WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY SIDE-EVENT:

World Breastfeeding Costing Initiative (WBCi) and its tool

Wednesday 21 May, 2014 | 17.45 – 19.00hrs | Room IX Palais des Nations, Geneva, Switzerland

Analysis of political commitment for breastfeeding reveals that investment for breastfeeding is necessary and needs strengthening. Development of realistic budgets to support implementation of evidence-based interventions that protect, promote and support optimal breastfeeding is however a complex task. International Baby Food Action Network (IBFAN) has developed a user-friendly tool to estimate resources required for policy and programme implementation in the framework of the *Global strategy for infant and young child feeding*. At this briefing an advocacy paper, "The Need to invest in Babies" and the new tool, which allows costing of such interventions, will be introduced and discussed.
